This hearing will determine whether or not Agri-Cycle will remain closed. As concerned citizens, we need to fill the courtroom and spill out into the hallways. This will show the court that we stand together against this business in our community. Please remember that this is a great opportunity for us to show our commitment in numbers and not in voice. Keep in mind, that this is a courtroom setting, so please arrive at the courthouse a little early so that we may orderly and quietly fill the courtroom, as there may be a large number of people present for this hearing.

There are many people in the community that may have not been informed about this hearing. Please pass this on to all of your neighbors and anyone else who might be able to attend the hearing to support our cause against Agri-Cycle.

One last reminder, this hearing will be held at the new Jackson County courthouse. If you are not familiar with its location, take Hwy 82 out of Jefferson toward Maysville. Go about $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile past the Jefferson Reservoir and take a right. This is General Jackson Parkway. Follow the signs and this will take you to the courthouse.
